On the nose this is a fresh approachable wine full of floral, sweet spice, passionfruit, and grassy aromas. The tropical fruit influences a hint of zingy pink guava, progressing into long lasting zesty lemon and lime to finish on the palate. This is a Sauvignon Blanc with great texture and juiciness that leaves you salivating.
