Winemakers' Notes

At the first glance, this wine's floral scents make it very pretty and approachable. Continuing on the nose are aromas of sweet spice, fennel and aniseed, fresh strawberry jam, and red berry coulis. It is fresh, elegant, balanced, and soft. The intense red fruit dominates the palate with hints of violet, white pepper, and aniseed sneaking in. This is a beautiful wine to show off to your friends at dinner parties.

Occasion

Recommended around the dinner table sharing a plump roast lamb and crispy roast potatoes.
