Variety:	Sauvignon Blanc

Colour:	Brilliant straw, refined golden tone
Bouquet:	Fresh guava, passionfruit and gooseberries with lingering lychees.
Palate:	Zesty citrus, crunchy green apples and snow pea notes leading to crisp and flinty minerality. Classy, fresh and clean, displaying great purity of fruit.
Harvest:	5th March 2012
Technical:	Alc -13%; TA - 7.8; pH—3.4; RS 1.68 -g/l
Cellaring:	Drink fresh

### FOOD MATCHES

Serve chilled with fresh shucked oysters, salt and pepper squid, Asian cuisine and fresh goats cheese.

### VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Weather conditions were mild during summer, with a few short periods of hot weather where temperatures exceeded 30°C. Generally, conditions during the majority of the ripening period were ideal, with mild day time temperatures and cold nights frequently below 10°C, all conducive to excellent flavour development and the retention of natural acidity in the fruit. A great vintage!

### WINEMAKING

Picked from three separate parcels and rushed straight to be pressed. Cool fermentation in stainless steel tanks.

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
