Colour:	Deep red with purple hues
Bouquet:	Intense aroma of plum and cherry with graceful herbal overtones
Palate:	Medium weight, rich and enticing succulent fruits of dark berry and plum, with some spice and a hint of oak. Good length, with refined tannins and a rewarding rich, smooth velvet mouthfeel
Harvest:	5th March 2010
Technical:	Alc: 13.8%; TA-606%; pH-3.46%; RS- 3g/l
Cellaring:	1 to 4 years

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

2010 was an outstanding season. A January heatwave resulted in early veraison about two weeks ahead of schedule. February and March saw cooler dry conditions for perfect ripening. The fruit was harvested in pristine condition.

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
